

Raeburn Orchards is a family owned and operated Perth business. It was first established in 1948 at the original site on Raeburn Road by our parents Giustino and Eufemia Casotti.

As the business and family grew, it expanded to an additional site on Chevin Road in 1961.

In the early 1980's the business was handed over to Giustino and Eufemia's two sons Peter & Paul Casotti and their families who still own and run the Orchard today.

In 1998 the families decided to purchase a third property in Jarrahdale to utilise the slightly different climate and further enhance our production of quality premium grade fruit.

Over the years we have endeavoured to keep up with the latest varieties of table fruit available, ensuring we are able to keep up with produce trends and public demand.

We pride ourselves in growing the freshest and best-tasting fruit, picking our crop when it is at its peak in size, colour, taste and sweetness.





Our orchard grounds consist of the main lot being 7.5 ha (75,000sqm) and our adjoining property a further 12.7ha (127,000sqm). This ensures that we able to produce the following fruits:


AUTUMN (APRIL - JUNE)

Throughout this period, once the fruit has been harvested the tree begins to shut down for the winter. At this time, the leaves will begin to change colour to warm vibrant hues of gold and orange before they shed from the tree.




















In winter, the majority of the trees are dormant, meaning that the trees are recovering from the past season and preparing for the year ahead. During this time, our staff are pruning the trees to prepare them for the upcoming season. With the cooler climatic conditions, the trees are also absorbing their required chill time, with most requiring a number of days below 5 degrees to enable the next seasons fruit to set.

SPRING

(SEPTEMBER - OCTOBER)

Come Spring, the trees begin to blossom which is followed by the leaves and the beginning of the small pieces of fruit. Within this period, it is also extremely important that the weather is warm to ensure the bees are active to enable pollination.

Stonefruit Harvest

Summer brings our key period for stone fruit as this is the time where the fruit begins to grow in size, change colour, develop its sweetness and is then harvested.







Willow Tree

Approx. Capacity
100–150

This is our most pristine location on the property, located at the highest point for orchard views. Your event will overlook the orchard and down through the valley of the darling ranges with all of your guests experiencing these beautiful views. At this location, there is a level area for a marquee to be setup and portable toilets to be placed. Guests will also be given the exclusive use of the sanctioned garden to mingle with guests whilst enjoying some food and beverages provided by the host. Your guests will also have access to our range of outdoor games.







Packing Shed

This location can be utilised throughout the winter months for a rustic style event. Your guests will be positioned amongst orchard machinery and packaging. This area is completely undercover with toilets located nearby.







Long Table

This location can also be utilised for a farm style event whilst having the ability to overlook parts of our orchard. Your guests will be positioned amongst orchard machinery with an open outlook to the orchard. The area is outside; however, toilets are located within close proximity.

This area will be subject to seasonal availability.

Function Area Information

Power

Power supply is provided to the designated function areas.

Water

Potable water connections are provided at the designated function areas.

Toilets

Raeburn Orchards has two public toilets available on premises, these are located in close proximity to function areas 'Long Table' and the 'Packing Shed'. Hire of portable toilets is the responsibility of the event host.

Lighting

All decorative lighting is to be supplied by the event host. Raeburn Orchard has access to limited general lighting in their outdoor spaces. Candles and sparklers are not permitted at any time in specific function areas— we recommend SafeFlame LED candles. Open fires are expressly prohibited during fire restricted times/seasons and as otherwise specified by the Government of Western Australia, or any of its instrumentalities.

Transport

Ample on-site parking is available for all three venue areas. Taxis and Uber bookings are recommended.

Rubbish Disposal

It is the responsibility of the event host to manage waste accumulation during the event. A discharge point will be provided by Raeburn Orchards pre and post event.

Smoking

Due to an ever-prevalent hazard in the hills, we request that patrons smoke only in designated areas which are required to be clearly communicated to guests.

Attire

Please note Raeburn Orchards is an outdoor venue and a working farm, appropriate footwear and clothing is advised. It is also recommended that guests bring warm clothing for evening events.

Pending the theming of your event, bump in times can be discussed upon formalising your booking.

Orchard Access

We wish to advise that access through the orchard during daylights hours is included within your booking, however upon sunset access is to be within your designated area only. If private orchard access to your guests is required, a request is to be included within your booking, it should be noted that additional fees may apply.

Deposit Requirements

A non-refundable deposit of \$250 is required to secure your booking. This initial deposit needs to be provided together with the completed forms outlined below. Balance of payment is to be paid 7 days prior to function date. Failure to receive payment will result in cancellation of your booking.
